• 12-1pm - Rhone Blending Class

Winemaker Sean Gilbert of Gilbert Cellars will lead a Rhone-blending class starting with delicious barrel samples of Grenache, Mourvedre and Syrah from the 2009 vintage. Sean will share stories from his recent trips to the Rhone Valley and Chateauneuf du Pape as well as maps and provide tastes of a northern and southern Rhone wine to compare their styles. Attendees will create their own blends from his barrel samples. \$35 General Admission.

• 12-1pm - Cabernet & Terroir

Meet Winemaker Tony Rynders of Swiftwater Cellars, who will take you on a tour thru three of Washington's top AVAs (Red Mountain, Horse Heaven Hills and Walla Walla). Taste Cabernet barrel samples of 2009 from each of these famous growing regions, followed up with a tasting of the '07 and '08 Swiftwater Cellars Proprietary Red - their Cabernet Sauvignon based blend that incorporates wines from all three vineyards. \$35 General Admission.
